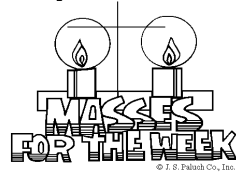

St. Joseph's grounds are for rent. Joel Penney gave the Church \$250 per acre for rent and so that is what we will start with in regards to bids for rent. The payment of rent is due on May 1st and on September 1st of 2018. The person with the highest bid will be able to rent the land for the year of 2018. When you send in your bids, put on the envelope, "bid for land".
